in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,
unto the said *Walter E. Robinson, Lewis Edie Robinson, Joseph H. Robinson, Jr. and Cassius D. Robinson*, in equal shares,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situated, lying and being
in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid
known as Lot "B", (According to a plat recorded in P. M. C.
office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "A" at page 496,
and having the following walls and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of East Third
Street, corner of lot "C" running thence N. 13-1/4 W. 200 feet to an
iron pin; thence S. 76-3/4 W. 54 feet to an iron pin corner of
lot "A"; thence with line of lot "A" S. 13-1/4 E. 200 feet to an iron
pin on North Street; thence with North Street, N. 76-3/4 E. 54 feet
to the beginning corner. This being one of the lots conveyed to
C. D. Hobbs by G. F. Hinkle and Company, by deed dated
September 3, 1917, and recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Vol. 51, Page 5, and being the same lot conveyed to
me by C. D. Hobbs, by deed dated the 5th day of October, 1917, and
