all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin  
.....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All our right, title and undivided interest in and to that certain tract of land  
inherited by us from our father, R. E. Chapman, deceased, about nineteen (19) miles  
from the Courthouse on the Augusta Road, known as the "Old Home Place", consisting  
of nine (9) acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of E. M. Blythe on the North,  
West and East and by lands of W. A. Allison on the South.

Also all of our right, title and undivided interest in and to that certain  
tract of land in the County and State aforesaid, known as the "Horse Creek Place",  
inherited by us from our father, R. E. Chapman, deceased, containing forty-six (46)  
acres, more or less, bounded on the West by lands of Ella Cobb and on the East by
