 By this Memorandum between A. G. Cappa of the first
 part, and W. H. Hammatt of the second part, it is mutually
 agreed that the party of the first part shall convey to the party
 of the second part the following land; 101 acres land just
 off New Buncombe Road on the old Buncombe Road known
 as Old Grammell place, on which is a 9 room dwelling and
 four rooms dwelling in overall house. W. H. Hammatt agrees
 to assume and pay \$3000.00 mortgage on the above place to
 gether with one year interest. W. H. Hammatt agrees to give
 a second mortgage on the above property in the sum of \$1000.00
 payable one year after date at 8% compound annually.
 And the party of the second part shall convey to the
 party of the first part its fall owing land, house and lots
 to be located the street being 14th & 15th houses. A. G. Cappa agrees
 to assume and pay mortgage in the sum of \$25.00. Also
 to assume Washington Road, on which A. G. Cappa agrees
 to assume and pay mortgages in the sum of \$3200.00 in
 stages one in the B. & L. Loan for \$2200.00 and a second
 for \$1000.00 to mat. be called before one year.
 All conveyance to be made on or before 10 days after date
 provided the titles are good and merchantable, interest, taxes
 and insurance to be prorated.

And as a further consideration each party has paid to
 the other party one dollar cash on signing of this contract.

And as a further consideration the party of the 1st part
 agrees to pay to the party of the 2nd part the sum of Dollars,
 as follows:
