Major was driven into the rear of a car parked in said N. Main Street, injuring W. J. Foster, from which injuries he later died, and the morning being foggy and very dark, and the said car so parked in said street and which the said W. J. Foster and others were attempting to push down the street, not having its head or tail lights burning, and as being visible to the said W. B. Major who from all appearances was driving at a moderate rate of speed, over the wife and children of the said deceased W. J. Foster, not holding against or charging the said W. B. Major with carelessness or recklessness in the operation of his car at the time of the accident, and knowing said W. B. Major was wholly without fault in that it was impossible for him to see thru the mist and fog, we freely and willingly enter into the following agreement with the said W. B. Major, who acknowledges no liability whatsoever as a result of the said accident.

We, Mrs. Mary Foster wife of the deceased W. J. Foster and Arthur P. Foster and Carrie Foster only living children of the said deceased W. J. Foster, in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by W. B. Major, hereby release and forever discharge the said W. B. Major of all liability and blame in the death of our said husband and father, W. J. Foster, the accident being without fault on the part of W. B. Major as aforesaid and

In consideration of the foregoing covenants and agreements on the part of Mrs. Mary Foster, Arthur P. Foster and Carrie Foster the said W. B. Major, while not confessing or admitting any liability in the premises whatsoever, but with a desire to help the family of the said deceased W. J. Foster, agrees to bear all the expense incident to the funeral and burial of the said deceased W. J. Foster, and upon the payment of the said funeral and burial bills by the said W. B. Major, he, the said W. B. Major, shall stand forever discharged of any and all liability arising from the death of the said W. J. Foster or arising out of the said car collision.
