 Order of Confirmation of Sale of Real Estate

Upon reading and filing the verified petition of the Trustee for the sale of real estate of the (bankrupt) estate of Octavius Bowen Hartzog, the Order of Sale by the Referee, the report of sale by R. H. Stanwell, Trustee, and the recommendation of the Referee, said sale having been held on the 9th day of May, 1932, at 10:00 o'clock, from the Greenville County Court House, Greenville, South Carolina, and being made subject to a first mortgage held by Mechanics Building and Loan Association, in the sum of \$14,500.00, being one-half of a total mortgage of \$29,000.00, covering the undivided one-half interest of Octavius Bowen Hartzog, described as follows:

- (1) Lot No. 232 of the Colonia Company property, in Greenville Township, fronting 60 feet on North Franklin Road, with a depth of 200 feet, and being the same lot conveyed to Mechanics Building and Loan Association by L. A. Trussel, by deed dated July 7, 1931, and recorded in the R. M. L. office for Greenville County, in Vol. 163, page 258, to which deed reference may be had for a more complete description.
- (2) Part Lot No. 12 of Block D, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 6, page 209, said lot fronting 53 feet on Washington Avenue, or road, with a depth in parallel lines of 200 feet, and being the same property conveyed to Mechanics Building and Loan Association by E. Dussman Master, by deed dated June 24, 1927, and recorded in the R. M. L. office for Greenville County in Vol. 139, page 62.
- (3) Lot in Greenville Township, fronting 70 feet on the east side of Brandon Road, with an average depth of 135 feet, and being the same lot conveyed to the Mechanics Building and Loan Association by Willard Goldsmith, by deed dated September 1, 1929 and recorded in the R. M. L. office for Greenville County in Vol. 137, page 255. Reference to which deed may be had for a more complete description.
