

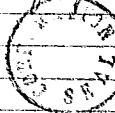

For and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five (\$35.00) Dollars and other valuable consideration in hand paid by the South Carolina Security Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Mortgage Corporation of Virginia, the owner and holder of a judgment obtained against J. F. Berry and Ernie C. Binn and filed in the Clerk of Court's office for Greenville County on January 29, 1931, designated as Judgment Roll # E-1875, and in the sum of Three Hundred Sixty four & 78/100 (\$364.78) Dollars have released from the lien of said judgment the following described property, to-wit:

All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Ward 15 of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, on the North side of Douthit Street and known and designated as Lot # 4 of the plat of J. F. and W. E. Berry or a plat thereof made by V. E. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, April 6, 1929 and recorded in the R. M. C.'s office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at Page 162, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Douthit Street 48.6 ft. from the Northwest intersection of Douthit Street and Lawton Avenue, joint corner of Lots #s 3 and 4 and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 17-12 E. 125.2 ft. to an iron pin near joint corner of said lots; thence S. 71-37 E. 67.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 18-45 W. 125.5 ft. to an iron pin in the line of Douthit Street; thence along the North side of Douthit Street N. 71-15 W. 64 ft. to the point of beginning.
