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Whereas, from time to time T. C. Gower and W. D. Parrish have by their several deeds of conveyance conveyed portions of said property referred to in the preceding paragraph to the South Carolina Highway Department, and to other persons by way of exchange, their action in each instance having been approved by the committee from Greenville County Delegation, and

Whereas, certain portions of lands above referred to have not been conveyed, and title thereto remains in T. C. Gower and W. D. Parrish, and

Whereas, W. D. Parrish did depart this life testate on the 18th day of October 1931, his will being on file in Apartment 280, File 18 in the Office of Judge of Probate for Greenville County, South Carolina, and

Whereas, Nell G. Parrish, as executrix and individually, has at the request of Greenville County Delegation, conveyed to T. C. Gower by quit claim deed all right, title and interest in the unsold portion of lands referred to in the schedule of deeds hereinabove mentioned, and

Whereas, said right-of-way has now been secured, and any and all of the unconveyed portions of said land should be sold as soon as practical, and

Whereas, it is the desire of Greenville County Delegation that T. C. Gower shall continue the plan as originally outlined, sell, trade and exchange any land which he may now have title to by virtue of facts hereinabove referred to,

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

1. That Greenville County Delegation does hereby ratify and confirm each and every deed, contract and agreement heretofore made by T. C. Gower and W. D. Parrish in connection with or incident to their duties as outlined in this Resolution, and does hereby obligate Greenville County to fully indemnify the said T. C. Gower and W. D. Parrish, their heirs, and assigns, against any and all loss which they, or either of them, may sustain by reason of their having executed general warranty deeds to any properties referred to herein, this to include any conveyance made in the future by T. C. Gower, who acting under and by virtue of authority contained in this Resolution.

2. That T. C. Gower be and is hereby authorized and requested to sell, exchange and convey, for such prices, and upon such terms and conditions as he may deem wise in his discretion, the unsold portions of properties hereinabove referred to: Provided, however, that all such contracts, agreements or deeds of conveyance shall be first approved by the Supervisor of Greenville County, said approval to be endorsed upon any contract, agreement or deed, and to be substantially in the following form: "I hereby approve the within instrument, _____ County Supervisor." All proceeds of sale, less expenses, shall be paid over to Greenville County, but the purchaser or purchasers shall not be required to see to application of the funds.

3. That T. C. Gower be paid for his services herein authorized such sum as may be mutually agreed upon by and between T. C. Gower and Greenville County Delegation.

4. That a copy of this Resolution be recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and that the same be ratified and confirmed by an appropriate Act of the General Assembly of South Carolina.
