

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sarah Little and Maggie Little,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville, on Ferry Avenue, fronting on Ferry Avenue 55 feet, more or less, with a rear line on Ware Street of 30 feet, more or less, with a depth of 114.5 feet, more or less, on the eastern side and a depth of 158 feet, more or less, on the western side.

This conveyance is made in full satisfaction and discharge of the mortgage for \$3500.00, executed by grantor to the grantees on May 30th, 1934, recorded in R. M. C. O. for said County in Book 142, page 177, but it is understood and agreed that said mortgage shall remain open as a protection against intervening encumbrances.

Grantees agree to pay taxes and paving which may be assessed against the property.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by J. P. Gleason, on the 30 day of May, 1924, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds, Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 01, Page 405
