Railway; on the South by Calvert Street; on the West by lot #25 and on the North by lots #12 and 13; Said lots having a frontage of 120 feet and running 146.5 feet on P. & N. Right of Way and being lots 26 and 27 on a plat of the J. R. West property made by A. S. Bedell. Said plat being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", at page 190.

Also all that place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina near the Easley Bridge Road, and being better known as lot #25 of a plat of the property of J. R. West made by A. S. Bedell, and duly recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County and State, to which plat reference is hereby made for a more complete description. Said lot fronts 60 feet on Calvert Street and has a depth on both sides of 146.5 feet and is 80 feet wide on the rear.
