In the State aforesaid the sum whereof is hereby acknowledged, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Hermann, his heirs, executors and assigns

all that place, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Containing 69 3/4 acres, known as the Billy Stokes' place, located on the Bearcreek Road, on waters of Bearcreek Creek, three miles north from Creek, S.C., bounded on the North by P. J. Stokes, on the east by Edell and Will Reed, on the south by G. W. Neely, and on the west by G. W. Neely and Thomas Stokes, and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat by J. H. Atkins, Esq. -
March 2, 1920:

Beginning at Red Oak 38 corner of George Neely's land, and running thence with line of the said Neely's land N. 27-19 W. 27-65 chains to stone 34; thence with line of P. J. Stokes' land N. 79-30 E. 34-13 chains to stone; thence with line of Will's land S. 18-52 E. 10-17 chains to iron pin in road; thence with said road S. 71-37 W. 5-44 chains to black gum; dead; thence with line of Reed's land S. 22-50 W. 32-46 chains to stone; thence with Neely's land N. 25-52 W. 10-85 chains to the beginning corner.
