## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

Greenville County.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Benjamin J. Fisher and Phoebe Fisher,

In the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five Dollars,  
and payment of taxes for the years 1932 and 1933  
to R. A. Abercrombie,

In the State aforesaid, the except whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. A. Abercrombie, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, all that given, parcel or lot of land in Greenville,  
about 1 1/2 miles northwest from the Court House, having the following mates and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Pinckney Street (now usually called Talley Street), said stake being 68½ feet more or less, from the west line of the road sometimes called Hammett Street, and being on the northwest corner of lot No. 19 in the plat hereinafter referred to), and running thence along said Pinckney Street S. 68½ W. 50 feet to stake on the northeast corner of the lot conveyed by Angelo P. Ballow to Stafford Ballow by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said county and state in Deed Book 46, page 135; thence along the Stafford Ballow line S. 21½ W. 190 feet to a stake on what was shown on the plat hereinafter referred to as a 10 foot alley, now known as "Mill Street"; thence along Mill Street S. 68½ E. 50 feet to a stake on corner of lot No. 19; thence with line of said lot N. 21½ E. 190 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the east half of lot No. 18 on map No. 3 of the Hammett lands made by W. A. Hulson, dated May 14, 1900, and recorded in said office in Deed Book HHH, page 635.

The above-described land in the same conveyed to me by Angelo P. Ballow, on the 1st day of February 1934, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 103, Page 13.
