

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Mrs. Ellen Wilson, of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, paid by her, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Wilson and her heirs and assigns all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the State aforesaid, the equity whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, are by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Wilson and her heirs and assigns all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situated, lying and being on the fourth block of the City of Greenville, said County and State of South Carolina, having the following notes and bounds according to a plat thereof by it to the lot, dated February 1901 to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of East Broad Street twenty (20) feet eastward from the west side of Boyce Street formerly known as 1st Street, said stake being on the southeast corner of the lot formerly conveyed to the said Mrs. Wilson as aforesaid, and being eight (8) feet westward from the boundary line between lots numbered one and two shown on said plat) and running thence S. 67° 4' E. along the north side of East Broad Street thirty three (33) feet to a stake on the southeast corner of lot numbered three on said plat, thence N. 20° 56' E. (128.6) one hundred twenty eight and 2/3 feet, more or less, along the west line of lot numbered three to a stake on property belonging to the W. B. Railway Company, thence along said property S. 70° 18' W. twenty five (25) feet to the northeast corner of lot no. 4, thence N. 66° 04' W. eight (8) feet to a stake on the northeast corner of said lot hereby conveyed to Mrs. Wilson, thence along the west line of said lot S. 20° 18' W. one hundred twenty eight and 2/3 (128.6) feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on Broad Street; the lot hereby conveyed being all of lot 2, 3 and 4, and a strip eight (8) feet in width cut from the eastern side of lot 2, 3 and 4, and a strip eight (8) feet in width cut from the eastern side of lot 4.

The above described lot is by Mrs. Wilson, the said subject to me by the authority of the said Mrs. Wilson, by deed dated and recorded in office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County, in Book 117, Page 211.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. Wilson, her heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant, defend, maintain and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs. Wilson, her heirs and assigns, against all and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
