to us paid by Corrie Evans,

In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Corrie Evans all our right, title and interest, of, in and to
all that gives, grows or lies of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
containing 30 acres, more or less, being more fully described by metes and bounds in
the deed of J. K. Huff to Ben Evans dated Jan. 4, 1927, recorded in R. M. C. O. for
said County in deed book 105 page 433.

Also that other tract of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid,
known as tract No. 1 on plat of J. Wister Stewart, of the James W. Huff lands, more
fully described in the deed of D. P. Cox to Ben Evans dated Nov. 28, 1906, recorded
in said R. M. C. O. in Book 125, page 125.

The said Ben Evans departed this life intestate February 5, 1882, leaving
surviving him as his sole heirs at law and distributees his widow Corrie Evans, the
grandmother herein, and his six children as follows: Sula Kelly, Maude Ligon, Stella
Stokes, William Evans, Patrick Evans and Benjamin Evans.

whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
