in the City of Greenville, on the west side of McMinn Street, known and designated as
 lot No. thirteen (13), on a plat of Mountain City Land & Improvement Company, recorded in
 Deed Book 77, page 605, and said lot has the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on the west side of McMinn Street, joint corner of lots Nos. 12 and 13;
 thence running with McMinn Street S. 18 W. 43 feet to corner of lot 14; thence with line
 of lot 14, N. 77 W. 204 feet to an alley; thence with said alley N. 18 E. 43 feet to
