on the road leading from Greenville to Pelham about 3 1/2 miles from Greenville Court

House and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on said road corner of W. H. Holcombe's land and running thence with his line, S. 32-05 W. 199.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the grantor's line, S. 55-25 E. 65 feet to an iron pin corner of grantor's land; thence with his line N. 33-03 E. 199.3 feet to the Greenville-Pelham Road; thence with said road, N. 55-25 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner.
