In the State aforesaid, the persons wherofe hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and cause unto the said Ora Evelyn Drake, her heirs and assigns

all that piece, place or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the section known as River Falls containing two (2) acres, more or less, and having according to a survey thereof made by W. A. Rester, Surveyor, September 13, 1834, the following notes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin, the Southeastern corner of John L. Drake and others property, a six (6) acre tract, and running thence N. $55\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.75 chains to a stone O. M. I. P.; thence W. 33 E. 7.22 chains to a stone O. M.; thence S. $78\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.02 chains to a stone by pine; thence S. $3\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.75 chains to an iron pin, the beginning corner; bounded on the North by lands of Charles and Beattie; on the West by tract conveyed by Thermuthis Drake Trammell to John L. Drake and others; on the South and East by lands of the Saluda River Lumber Company.

This property is part of the tract of land conveyed to Thermuthis Trammell by Mary A. Drake, individually, and J. D. Trammell as Executor of the Estate of C. G. Drake, dated November 4, 1836, recorded in Deeds, Volume 117, Page 288, being the same tract to which the grantee has executed quit-claim deed to Thermuthis Trammell.
