 Beginning at a pine tree; thence S. 42° E. 17.50 to a pin; thence N. 30° E. 12.00 to a  
 stake; thence N. 42° E. 17.50 to a stake; thence S. 30° W. 12.00 to the beginning  
 corner, and containing twenty acres, more or less, and being part of the sixty acre  
 tract of land described in deed of Benjamin F. Pinson to S. C. Pinson for his one-  
 third interest therein, and adjoining lands of D. Z. Pike, R. L. Gallimore and the
