In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Silla Green for life and then to Devett Green, Boyd Green, Marvise Green and Frances Green all that gives, passes or let of land in near the city of Greenville, TENNESSE Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

being lot #102, of a sub-division known as Morgan Hill, plat of which is duly recorded in the office of R. M. C. for the State and County aforesaid, having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Parker Avenue and running thence N. 87-45 W. 197.5 feet to an iron pin on O'Neal's line, thence with O'Neal's line N. 12-30 W. 62 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 88-15 E. 199.3 feet to an iron pin on Parker Avenue, thence with Parker Avenue S. 12-45 E. 57.72 feet to the beginning corner.
