

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that William J. Johnson

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars,

to see paid to J. D. Massey

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, to be granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. D. Massey, his heirs and assigns;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

just beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and north of Greenville Court House; having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest corner of a street called Johnson Street and the old Cedar Lane Road, and running thence from said pin N. 19 N. along said Johnson Street, 180 feet to an iron pin on corner of the other land belonging to Nancy Johnson; thence N. 49 1/2 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 19 W. 182 feet to iron pin on north side of said Cedar Lane Road; thence S. 49 1/2 E. along said road 180 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land which was conveyed to me, said William J. Johnson, by Mrs. Nancy Johnson, January 6, 1904, by deed recorded in Deed Book 544, page 311, R. E. C. Office for Greenville County.

AND I do hereby bind myself in deed, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. D. Massey, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
