

LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, }
County of Greenville.

Frank Cameriere, Administrator Estate of H. Price lessor,
in consideration of the rental hereinafter mentioned, have granted, bargained and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto

Price Store, Inc., Greenville, S. C. lessee,

for the following use, viz: Leasing Store and Market the

premises being situated with easement at 725 Rainsville

St. Greenville, S. C.

for the term of three (3) years beginning March 15, 1935

and the said lessee

in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promises to pay the said lessor the sum of Fifty (50.00)

Dollars

per month to be paid in advance payable each month on the 15th day of each month

The lessor hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessee only require of the lessor the use of the

premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the roof should it leak. It is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the

lessor not to pay any damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the

lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the business is discontinued on the premises wanted before the expiration of the lease then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due

and payable.

Outside structure to be erected shall only consist with the purpose of the building and be connected to by the lessor before be-

ing erected. The lessor to have good and service annual available

at a cost of one dollar per month season in to enable following

the lessor in the event at his expense: (1) Clean house in winter

of paint and replace broken glass places. (2) Repair or replace

small leak holes. (3) Repair front and rear screen door windows.

(4) Paint 30" x 30" display windows either side of front door.

(5) Remove light from side porch. (6) Clean and paint front

porch. (7) Clean and paint of electric wiring in attic and places of

where rats will place their nests. (8) Clean and paint inside

of main door. (9) Clean and paint inside of front entrance

porch. (10) Clean and paint inside of rear entrance. (11) Clean and paint

inside of porch. (12) Clean and paint inside of rear porch. (13) Clean and paint

inside of rear porch. (14) Clean and paint inside of rear porch.

To Have and to hold the said premises unto the said lessee, Price Store, Inc., its successors and assigns

and administrators for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the

party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party two months written notice previous

to the time of the desired termination, but the destruction of the premises by fire or making it unfit for occupancy or other casualty, or two

months amount of rent, shall terminate this lease, if the lessor so desires. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass and all other injuries done to the

premises during the term, except such as are produced by natural decay and agree to make no repairs, improvments or alterations in the premises without the

written consent of the lessor and without the lessor's written consent. He agree to pay the 300.00 balance with Co.

The lessee hereby acknowledges having a duplicate of this lease.
