

LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

in consideration of the rental hereinabove mentioned, have granted, bargained and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto

J. R. Hicks

lessor,

for the following use, viz.: *The operation of a beauty shop and affiliated*

purposes

Block Building located at 229 Augusta St, Greenville, S.C.

for the term of *Five (5) years from the date of this lease.*

in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promises to pay the said lessor the sum of *Sixty and no/*

(\$60.00) Dollars

*per month payable on the 1st day of each month beginning
as of the 1st day of Dec 1939 and each month thereafter during the term of this lease.*

The lessee hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessee only require of the lessor the use of the premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the roof should it leak, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the lessor not to pay any damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the business is discontinued as the premises vacated before the expiration of the lease then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due and payable.

Outside signs to be erected that may connect with the parapet or any other outside part of the building must be consented to by the lessor before being erected.

It is understood and agreed in further consideration of the lease of the building hereinafter referred to, that the lessee shall have an option to buy said building for the sum of \$5,500.00 cash for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this lease and thereafter shall have the right to the first offer and refusal to buy the premises at a price set by the lessor. It is further agreed that the lessor will, in case of the discontinuance of the furnishing of beauty parlour, furnish a good method to let said building, this not to include fuel. The description of the premises sole as a beauty parlor located at 229 Augusta St, Greenville, S.C. and known as "The Lucile Beauty Salon".

No lease to be held by the said premises under the said lease.

executors and administrators for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party *one (1)* months written notice previous to the time of the desired termination, but the destruction of the premises by fire or making it unfit for occupancy or other casualty, or *one (1)* months arrear of rent, shall terminate this lease, if the lessor so desires. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass and all other injuries done to the premises during the term, except such as are produced by natural decay and agree to make no repairs, improvements or alterations in the premises without the written consent of the lessor nor sub-rent without the lessors written consent.
