

LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,
County of Greenville.

Mrs. A. G. Bullock lessor,
in consideration of the rental hereinafter mentioned, have granted, bargained and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto
H. L. Weathers and A. B. Weathers lessee,
for the following use, viz: grocery store
the
property hereinafter described
for the term of three (3) years beginning this day, to wit, November
3, 1945

and the said lessee
in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promises to pay the said lessor the sum of Twenty five and
no/100 (\$25.00) Dollars
per month payable in advance on the first of each
month

The lessor hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessee only require of the lessor the use of the premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the roof should it leak, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the lessor not to pay any damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.
If the business is discontinued or the premises vacated before the expiration of the term then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due and payable.

Outside signs to be erected that may connect with the parapet or any other outside part of the building must be consented to by the lessor before being erected.

The property herein leased is described as follows:
That certain store building now occupied by the
Service Bureau at Paris, in the County and State
above said, on left of highway traveling eastward, in
front of Paris Baptist Church

To have and to hold the said premises unto the said lessee and their executors and administrators for the said term. It is covenanted by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party three months written notice previous to the time of the desired termination. In the event of the destruction of the premises by fire or making it unfit for occupancy or other casualty, or two months arrear of rent, shall terminate this lease, if the lessor so desires. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass and all other injuries done to the premises during the term, except such as are produced by natural decay and agree to make no repairs, improvements or alterations in the premises without the written consent of the lessor nor sub-let without the lessor's written consent.
