All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, County and State aforesaid, containing Fourteen and 75/100 (14.75) acres, more or less, according to a survey by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated December 1927, and bounded by lands of J. P. Taylor, Sr., Lee Smith and others, being more completely described as follows: Beginning at a stone at the southeast corner of said tract and running thence N. 87.47 W. 1185 feet to a stone and iron pin; thence N. 6.40 E. 834 feet to R. O.; thence N. 6.23 E. 396 feet to poplar; thence S3.20 E. 318.5 feet to iron pin; thence S. 18.05 E. 164 feet to stone; thence S6.08 E. to old Taylor Corner stone; thence along the old Taylor line to the beginning corner, this being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed dated December 30th, 1927, by M. L. Littlefield and Elma DeShields, and recorded in Deed Book I, at page 540, in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County.

Also, all that parcel, piece or tract of land in O'Neal Township County and State aforesaid, containing Twelve and 1/3 Acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of J. P. Taylor Sr. W. P. Vaughn and others and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a stone on line of the old T. M. Bramlett land and running N. 5 E. 18.10 chs. to a stone; thence S6.80 E. 7.92 chs. to stone; thence S. 2.2 W. 15 chs. to stone; thence N. 88.35 W. 8.50 chs. to the beginning corner.
