(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Conveyed, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

D. L. Stegner and Mrs. Anabel H. Stegner, all of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, bounded by lands of J. C. Hipp, N. H. Hart, and by tract number 2 and 3 of the subdivision of the home place of said late M. L. Burdett, and being tract number 1 of said subdivision, as is shown on plat of Survey made by W. G. Riddle, Dec. 1932 of the estate of said M. L. Burdett, after having mete and bound as follows:

Beginning at stone pin in the middle of the public road, corner of tract #2 and of lands of estate of J. C. Hipp, and running thence, along said road 18° 74'-108' 412" (ft) to iron pin in the road; thence 818' E 31° to pin, N. H. Hart's corner; thence with Austin line S. 63-15 E. 223' to pin; thence with Austin line S. 6-15 E. 1785' to stone, J. C. Hipp's corner; thence with Hipp's line N. 53-30 W. 1264' to pin, corner of tract #2, thence along tract #2 N. 3-15 W. 829' to pin; thence continuing along line of tract #2 N. 23-15 E. 507' to pin near the road; thence S. 168-15 E. 131' to P. O. Stump; thence N. 18 E. 21.5' to the beginning corner, containing Thirty-Two acres, more or less, and being a part of the 45 acre tract of land conveyed to said M. L. Burdett by Deed recorded in Office of Greenville County in Vol. 1-108, 114-47, 120-416, & 120-417.
