All that certain parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate in Fairview
Township, County and State aforesaid on Branch Waters of Reedy River, containing 45 acres,
more or less, bounded by other lands Mary A. Davis, branch waters of Reedy River and lands
now or formerly of Mrs. F. E. Moore. This being the same property conveyed to Mary A.
Davis by D. P. Verner, Master, by deed dated Dec. 3, 1895, recorded in the R. M. C. office
for Greenville County in Deed Book BBB, at page 657, reference being craved to said deed
for a more particular description.

Also all that other certain tract of land adjoining the above described tract in
said township, county and state containing 41.3 acres, more or less, bounded by above
tract, lands now or formerly of W. E. Moore, lands now or formerly of Mrs. F. E. Moore and
branch waters of Reedy River, this being the same property conveyed to Mary A. Davis by
Mrs. F. E. Moore by deed dated Feb. 16, 1897 recorded in said office in deed book CCC at
page 637, reference being craved to said deed for a more particular description.
