All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situated being and bounded on both sides by the dry
Rock Creek, about two miles south of the Greenville
County Line, known as Tract No. 2, in the
County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina,
containing fifty four and 7/8 (54.75) acres, and
being bounded on the north by lands now or
formerly of Johnson and lands of the grantor,
designated as tract No. 2, and the lot above men-
tioned, from which the tract hereby conveyed is
separated by line extending from stone No. 24,
667 feet, on the east by said lands of the grantor
and lands of Mr. John Peacock, and the south by lands of
the estate of Harris, and on the west by lands
of Harris and lands now or formerly of Ashmore.
said lands being more fully shown and de-
lineated as tract No. 1, containing 54.70 acres and
embracing the same prepared by Dalton & Neves,
January, 1833, and being part of the lands hereto-
fore conveyed to the grantor by C. A. Murray, Master
for Greenville County, by deed dated 15 December,
1833, recorded in the R. M. Office for Greenville
County in Book of Deeds 165 at page 402.
