Lease

This indenture, made and concluded at Greenville, South Carolina this the 15th day of December 1952, by and between the Spartan Realty Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of S.C., the lessor by the first part and Robert Wilson, the lessee of the second part.

Witnesseth:

That the Spartan Realty Company, a corporation, has granted and leased unto the said Robert Wilson the Liberty Theater situated in the Liberty Building, on the west side of South Spring Street, in the City of Greenville, State aforesaid, together with all equipment now or hereafter in said theater, belonging to the lessor, including all other property, rights in said theater that may be obtained by lessor on account of ten per cent against the grosses thereof.

To have and to hold unto the said Robert Wilson his executors, administrators and assigns for the full term of one year commencing the 1st day of January 1953 and ending on the 31st day of December 1953, yielding and paying therefrom at the rate of \$240.00 per week, payable at the rate of \$200.00 per month in advance.

And it is mutually understood by and between the lessor and the lessee that the lease shall have the right of renewing this lease, after the expiration thereof, for a period of four or five years, after the expiration of this lease.

And the said Robert Wilson his executors, administrators and assigns for and in consideration of the above letting premises does hereby agree to pay the Spartan Realty Company the sum of \$200.00 weekly stipulated rent in the manner herein required.

And it is further stipulated and understood by the parties to these presents, that if the lessee shall, at any time, be thirty days in arrears with the rent the lessor shall have the right to remove and terminate this lease.

It is mutually understood and agreed that the termination of the premises by fire or any other casualty shall terminate this agreement at the option of the lessor.

It is mutually understood and agreed that the lessor shall at all times keep the said theater comfortably heated and furnished the necessary water and keep the outside of theater inhabitable repair.

It is mutually understood by and between the parties hereto that the lessor, is to, at his own expense, keep the interior of said theater in a good condition and shall not make any repairs and alterations therein at the expense of the lessee and all such repairs and alterations the lessor may desire to put in at his own expense and with the consent of the lessor, on the lessors removal.
