Goldsmith, of the State and County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars in hand paid to me by the Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do, on behalf of myself, my heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, consent for the said Piedmont & Northern Railway Company to remove the present overhead bridge over its tracks leading into my residence just North of the station of Henry, about three or four miles from the Greenville County Courthouse in the State and County aforesaid and do further release the said Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, its successors and assigns from all claims, demands, actions or rights of action of every nature whatsoever now existing or hereafter to arise for or on account of construction and operation of said railroad as now constructed through my property, including erosion or breaking off of the banks and washes therein.
