In consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars paid to me by Brandon Corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, James Thomas Wynn, the owner of lands owned near Pecky River in the County and State aforesaid do hereby release Brandon Corporation from any liability on account of or growing out of the construction, maintenance and operation by Brandon Corporation of a sewage and waste disposal system including sewage disposal plant and bleaching and dye waste loading basins and pipe lines emptying into Pecky River at or near its plant and property near Traveler Post in the County and State aforesaid and above the lands owned by me and do hereby grant unto Brandon Corporation, its successors and assigns the right and easement to maintain and operate a sewage and waste disposal system to empty into Pecky River the effluent therefrom.
