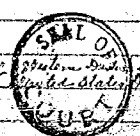
Whereas James Paschal Taylor of Deer, S.C. Greenville County, has been duly adjudged a bankrupt, under the act of Congress relating to Bankruptcy, and appears to have conformed to all the requirements of law in that behalf.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said James Paschal Taylor be discharged from all debts and claims which are made payable by said acts against his estate and which existed on the 9th day of May A.D. 1933, on which day the petition for adjudication was filed by him, excepting such debts as are by law excepted from the operation of a discharge in bankruptcy.
