 It is further agreed and as a part of this consideration hereof, that the grantors herein, as aforesaid, her successors, heirs and assigns, may make taps or connections with said pipe lines, at the own expense, to reach not more than the same number of buildings now on the premises, provided, however, that such connections be made only under the rules and supervision of the engineer representing Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission or their successors. Provided further, grantors may make as many taps as the land may be divided into lots on some conditions.

It is further understood and agreed that in case of future damage to crops or property due from accident in said pipe lines that Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission shall pay reasonable damage therefor.

The payment and privilege above specified are hereby accepted in full settlement of all claims and demands for said easement.
