

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, situate, lying and being on the Brushy Creek Road about five miles West from the Town of Greer, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having such shape, metes, courses and distances as will more fully appear by reference to a plat thereof, made by H. Gutterbridge as Addie Iola Vaughn, by deed of date December 23, 1914, from Ila Vaughn Hudson and others, heirs at law of John T.
