TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, William Elliott, Robert Gage, and N. M. McMill, as Receivers of Peoples State Bank of South Carolina

on or about the 30th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty two exhibited their complaint in the Court of Sessions for the County aforesaid, against S. W. Taylor and J. P. Taylor

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 24th day of January, 1933, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree
