All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, about one mile North West of Greer, and adjoining lands of C. W. Ballenger, E. E. Reese, and myself and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from D. H. Gibson, Jan. 8th, 1921, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Volume 89, at page 155, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning on an iron pin in the road leading from Greer to Oneal, on A. B. Groce's line, and runs thence with the said road N. 44 W. 8.06 chains to an iron pin in the said road on C. W. Ballenger's line; thence with the said line N. 11-1/2 E. 3.33 chains to an iron pin on the eastern side of a settlement road, E. E.
