LEASE

This memorandum of agreement, made and entered into this the 26 day of October 1932, by and between L. M. Davenport, bersinefter referred to for convenience as Lesson, and Thos. L. Smith, doing business as Smith & James, referred to hereinafter as Lessea, with the convenience of the convenience of

- 1. That in consideration of the monthly routal and other stipulations hereinafter set forth to be performed upon the part of the lesses, the said lessor hereby leades and lets unto the raid lesses, effective January 1, 1933, the store building located at 45 South Trade Street, Green, South Carolina, the said premises being now occupied by T. Danny Smith, for a period of three years and one month, or ending February 1, 1936.
- 2. The lesses agrees to rept and lesse from the lesser the said stree building bereinbefore mentioned, and serves to pay as reptal the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars por someth for the first year of this lease contract, and agrees to pay the sum of Sixty Five (\$65.00) Dollars for south from the second year of this lease contract, and beginning January 1, 1915, or the last shirteen menths of this lease contract, lesses agrees to pay to lesser the sum of Seranty (\$70.00) Dollars per menth, said monthly payments to be made on or before the first of the month following the month for which the said reptal is due. It is understood and agreed by and between the lessor and lesses, however, that the increase in monthly reptal from Sixty to Sixty Five Dollars, is conditioned upon the general business improvement as compared with the year 1932.
- 3. The lesser hereby agrees to make certain reparts or alterations in the building herein lessed, but said repairs or alterations are to be suggested by lesses, and lesser is not to expand on making said repairs or alterations more than Seven Hundred Fifty (3750.00) boilars, unless however, lesses finds it absolutely necessary to have more repairs and alterations made than can be done for the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars, in which event lesser agrees to expend on said repairs or alterations an additional sum of not exceeding two Sundred Fifty Dollars, lesses agreeing to pay lesser interest at the rate of eight per cent. On all expenditures for repairs and alterations in excess of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars, said interest to be paid morthly with rent throughout the life of this centract.
- 4. Lease agrees to surrender possession of the said store building at the expiration of the term herein fixed, or any extension thereof, in the same condition as then lesses first exceptes the same, ordinary sear and tear and usage thereof excepted; it is understood and agreed by and between the contracting parties herein that the death to tion of, or material damage to the said building by fire or other casualty, will, at the option of either party hereto immediately terminate and end this contract.
- 5. It is further understood and agreed by and between the contracting parties herein, that in addition to the lease period herein specified, lessee is given the right and option of leasing said building for an additional period of two years beginning with the first of February 1936, on the same conditions except that the monthly rental for the two year additional lease, should same be claimed by said lessee, will be Seventy Pive Bollars per month.
- 6. It is also understood by and between the contracting parties herein that upon the failure of the lesses to well and faithfully perform any and all the covenants and conditions hereinspecified upon their part, the lessor may end and terminate this agreement and take possession of the building without prejudice to any of his legal rights as to the collection of rents or otherwise.
- 7. Any change in this lease contract shall be indered in writing and signed by the respective parties hereto, or their respective representatives.
- 8. This agreement to enure to the benefit of, and be binding upon the respective parties hereto, their respective heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns according to the true intent, meaning and tenor hereof.
