That the Lessor agrees to lease to the Lessee the tract of land situate in said County containing Eleven acres, known as the Stone's Lakes, For the purpose of Game & Fish propagation, place in Greenville Township, Greenville County,

To Hold the same to the Lessee from the first day of Jan. 1933, to the thirty first day of December, 1937.

And the Lessee on his part agrees to pay to the Lessor, as rent for the same One Dollar (\$1.00).

The lessee agrees to take good care of the premises, and to deliver possession of same at expiration of lease without further notice. This agreement to bind the parties, their heirs, executors, and administrators.
