all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

being known and designated as Tract No 5 according to a plat made by James S. Miller, D.S., December 22, 1926, and being a part of the property of the Estate of Malinda Chapman, said tract of land having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone 320 m at the southeast corner of said Tract no 5, and running thence N. 12 3/4. 18.57 ch. to a stone; thence S 83 1/2. 24.33 ch to a stone 31 7/8 m; thence S. 57. 16 ch to a stone; thence N 13 E. 28 ch. to the point of beginning, said tract of land being bounded (in 1896) on the south by Lot no 4; on the East by Charles Bacon land, on the north by Lot no 6; and on the West by J. T. Cooley, and containing 40 1/2 acres, more or less.

Also, the following parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Dunklin Township, containing 34 acres, more or less, and being described by metes and bounds according to plat of property of D. V. Chapman, as made in January 1925 by J. F. Riddle, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of property of Epp and D. V. Chapman, and running thence S. 34 30 E. 23.50 ch to an iron pin, corner of Ed. King and Mrs Halliday property, thence N. 84 30 E. 9.40 to a stake in creek, thence along the creek as the line 12.16 ch to a stake; thence S 84 25 N. 7.38 ch along the line of W. D. Workman property to a stone; thence S 83 6 21. 127.03 ch along the line of D. V. Chapman property to a stone; thence S. continuing along line of D. V. Chapman property 9.15 N. 6. 71 ch to the beginning.
