in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. E. Fuller, W. M. Chappell, T. M. Riley, La La Childs and Mr. Maxwell as Trustees for Fuller Normal and Industrial

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Institute, their heirs, successors and assigns; (Fuller Normal and Industrial Institute is a school owned and controlled by Fire Baptized Holiness Church of God of the Americas)

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 7.7 acres, more or less, being about two miles from Greenville County Court House, between the Anderson Road and the right of way of the Columbia and Greenville Railroad, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake 3^X corner of Nichols Land in the Anderson Road, and running thence S. 43-30 E. 587 feet, more or less, to a stake x^o on the railroad right of way; thence with said railroad right of way S. 63-130 W. 260 feet, to rock, 40 m on said right of way, thence S. 70-30 W. 386 feet to rock 0m on said right of way, thence S. 75-30 W. 190 feet to rock 40 m in said right of way; thence N. 22¹/₂ W. 375 feet and 6 inches to staple x^o in the Anderson Road, thence in and along the Anderson Road N. 58 E. 367 feet to a post oak (gong) in said road; thence N. 49 1/2 E. 275 feet to beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. O. Allen by Elizabeth Neal Mental by deed dated April 25, 1913, and recorded in the C.M.C. Office for said Greenville County in Book 18 at page 309.

This deed is made under the authority of the last will and testament of James O. Allen, deceased, wherein it is provided that the executors of said will may sell any of the land of the Estate of James O. Allen, upon such terms and at such times as may be deemed best, said will being on file in the Office of the Probate Judge of Greenville County in Apartment 326 File 10.

The grantees shall give a purchase money mortgage on the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000.00) Dollars to H. T. Tolson, Attorney which mortgage is to be held for the benefit of the Estate of James O. Allen, deceased, and to pay out of said mortgage funds as collected a mortgage to Mrs. F. Ligon, recorded in Mortgage Book #215 page 66, R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County, to pay all taxes on said land through the year 1935, and to pay the debts of the Estate of James O. Allen deceased, and to be administered according to the terms of the said will.
