All that certain piece of property in Black Springs Township, County and State aforesaid and more particularly described as follows:

Lot with one story shingled house on Highland Ave. of a subdivision of part of the property of the Black Spring Company, and described as follows: Commencing at a stake on Highland Avenue, corner of lot no 9 of a subdivision of part of property of the Black Spring Company known as the "Highlands"; thence with north side of said Avenue N 67-51 W. 70 ft. to a stake, corner of lot no 11; thence with line of lot no 11 N. 22-09 E. 175 ft. to a stake on the line of the Mrs. Homer Goldsmith property; thence along line of said property S. 67-51 E. 70 ft. to a stake on corner of lot no 9; thence along the line of lot no 9 S. 22-09 W. 175 ft. to a stake on Highland Avenue at the point of beginning.

The above lot is known as lot no 10 in subdivision of part of property of the Black Springs Company as per survey and plat made July 1915 by R. E. Dalton C. E., Greenville, S. C.

Subject however to the following conditions and limitations which are hereby declared to be conditions subsequent.
