All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and buing in the State of South Caroline, County of Greenville and City of Greenville, and buing a protion of the same lands represented upon the plat of Crescent Terrace, also being a portion of the said lands conveyed to Poinsett Realty Commany by S.
