In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release, unto the said R. L. Childress, and his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of
land situate, lying and being in Chick Spring
Township, near the Town of Gadsden, County and
State aforesaid, having the following courses
and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an iron
pin near branch in line of R. L. Childress land,
land running thence N. 50° 45' E. 150 feet to iron pin,
thence S. 39° 15' E. 200 feet to iron pin; thence N. 33 E.
34° 2.7 feet to iron pin, thence S. 39° 15' E. 960.5 feet to
iron pin in road; thence along road S. 38° 10' W.
100 feet; thence S. 35° 40' W. 100 feet; thence S. 34° 45' W.
200 feet; thence S. 25° 15' W. 100 feet to stone; thence N.
39° 15' W. 1304.3 feet to the beginning corner, containing
11.6 acres more or less, according to plat of
H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, of the J. N. De Young
property dated September, 1932, and designated
thereon as Tract number Two.
