in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. E. Roman 1/5 of my undivided interest; unto

the said Hattie M. Bull, E. B. Bell, Ida P. Carter, Annie L. Berry and W. E. Bright 1/4 of my undivided interest; unto the said E. B. Caldwell, L. A. Caldwell and Fannie V. Wood 1/5 of my undivided interest; and unto the said O. H. Roman and Mary B. Meares 1/4 of my undivided interest in and to all that piece parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following meters and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the old Roman line; thence S. 81 1/2° E. 29.30 to a stake; thence S. 65 3/4° E. 5.00 to a stake; thence N. 24 3/4° W. 28.10 to a stake; thence N. 59 1/2° E. 9.00 to a stake, the beginning corner, and containing 25 acres, more or less.

The grantor and grantees herein are the sole heirs at law and distributees of W. P. Roman and said heirs at law have this day made mutual deeds for the partition of the various tracts of land belonging to the estate of the said W. P. Roman
