All my right, title and interest in and to the following described lot of land, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina in the town of Greer, described by notes and bounds as follows, according to a Plat made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor October 25th 1933.

Beginning at a point on Hill Street, corner of E. S. Dobson's lot and running along line of said lot S. 25-31 W. 82.3 ft. to an iron pin; thence continuing with Dobson's line S. 8-17 E. 190 ft. to iron pin on line of Southern Railway right-of-way; thence with said right-of-way N. 89-25 W. 50 ft. to iron pin on line of lot owned by Planter's & Savings Bank (formerly owned by Zimmerman); thence with line of lot Planter's Savings Bank N. 13-20 W. 185 ft. to iron pin; thence continuing with line of said lot N. 15-05 W. 167.2 ft. to pin on Hill Street; thence with Hill Street S. 61-39 E. 166.5 ft. to the point of beginning.
