Arthur Neves, Lizzie N. Brumlett, Lula

H. Neves, Frank E. Neves, B. Earl Neves, Ella Neves, Angie H. Fowler and Toy J. Neves, their heirs and assigns forever.

All my right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at Rock Hill, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a nail in the Runcombe road at the intersection of the road leading to the H. A. Taylor place, and running thence N. 60° 15' W. along said Runcombe road 336 feet to another nail in said road; thence N. 40° 45' W. 1678 feet to stake on the Coal line, thence N. 43° 50' E. 1357 feet to stake on tract no 2; thence S. 61° E. 1417 feet to stake on the "aylor line; thence S. 23° E. 1506.6 feet to iron pin in road; thence along said road S. 31° 30' W. 395.5 feet to the beginning corner, and containing sixty-five and thirty-two one hundredths (65.32) Acres, more or less, and known as tract no 3 of the Neves land, according to a survey by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor in September, 1933.
