KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Christ Church, an eleemosynary,

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, located _____ and having its principal place of business at Greenville _____ in the State of South Carolina, _____ for and in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5,00) Dollars and the recitals hereinafter made _____ DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee _____ hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto _____

Christ Church Cemetery,

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, lying south of North Street, East of Church Street, and being bounded by those streets and other property of the grantor, and being all of the land shown on a "Revised Map of Christ Church Cemetery, Greenville, S. C.," made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March 1928, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County on June 2nd, 1933, in Plat Book H, Page 300. This deed is intended to convey all the property shown on said map E X C E P T the following:

(a) That portion of said land on the East side of North Church Street which lies West of the roadway which leads from the North Gate, passes in front of the Church Edifice and terminates at the South Gate.

(b) That portion of said land on the East side of North Church Street and lying South of the roadway extending from said South Gate and in front of the Sunday School Building and the Markley Parish House.

(c) A circular lot, surrounded by roadways, and situate approximately in front of the Sunday School Building.

(d) That lot lying North of, and across the path from, the present Church Edifice, bounded on the South by said path, on the North and West by roadways leading from the North Gate, and on the East by lot marked on said plat "Col. S. S. Crittenden."

(e) All the land on which the present Church Edifice now stands and the land immediately surrounding it, not shown by said map as being used for roadways, paths and burial lots.

This conveyance is made subject to the rights of all lotholders legally acquired prior to the execution of this deed of conveyance.

This deed is made pursuant to resolutions duly adopted by the Vestry of Christ Church, an eleemosynary corporation, at its regular meeting held at the office of the Rector on the evening of October 9th, 1933.
