the sum of One \$10,000 DOLLARS,
and other valuable consideration

to it is and duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Lullwater Syndicate Inc.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on, which is situated the mill buildings formerly known as Beaver Duck Mills and consisting of the following described tracts:

First: All that certain tract of land situate in the Laurens Road County and State, aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3x N M in the bend of road corner of S. 53 E. 18. 85, thence S. 62 1/2 W. 4.50 to stone 3x N M, thence N. 82 1/2 W. 2. 95 to poplar, thence N. 67 1/2 W. 3.60 to pine 3x N M, thence N. 41 3/4 W. 5.40 to stone 3x N M on road, thence N. 6 E. 3.12 to pine 3x N M; thence N. 38 1/2 W. 9.44 links to sweet gum 3x N M, thence S. 33 1/2 W. 3.96 to sweet gum 3x N M, thence N. 81 1/2 W. 6.27 to sweet gum 3x N M, thence N. 64 1/2 W. 2.80 to stone 3x N M, thence S. 81 1/2 W. .09 to stone 3x N M, thence N. 64 1/2 W. 3.74 to stone 3x N, thence S. 80 1/2 W. 3.40 to stone 3x N M, thence N. 74 1/2 W. 3.50 to stone 3x N, thence N. 53 1/2 W. 2.34 to stone 3x N; thence N. 6 1/2 W. 3.73 to stone 3x N M; thence N. 64 1/2 W. 1.22 to stone 3x N M; thence S. 7 1/2 W. 4. to black gum, thence S. 22 1/2 W. 31.40 to point on old Laurens Road; thence with old Laurens Road S. 60 1/2 E. 3.21 to bend in road; thence S. 69 E. 4.70 to state under the beetle in the middle of Laurens Road; thence with Laurens Road S. 69 E. 10.30 to a stone; thence with Laurens Road S. 71 1/2 E. 5.50 to bend; thence with Laurens Road S. 75 1/2 E. 10.30 to the beginning. Containing sixty-three (63) acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Louach Cotton Mills by Beaver Duck Mills, by deed dated June 26, 1920.

Second: All that tract of land containing ten and one-half (10 1/2) acres, more or less, situate about one and one-half miles East of Greenville Court House, in the County and State aforesaid on the north side of the Greenville and Laurens Railroad, and on both sides of branches of Richland Creek, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake 3x N M in the middle of the G. & P. R.R. on the old line, and running thence with said line N. 29 1/2 E. 9.50 to stone 3x N M, crossing branch, thence N. 38 1/2 W. 5.60 to a stone crossing the creek on the south side of the road, thence S. 42 1/2 W. 13.41 to a stone 3x 0 m (sweet gum gone) thence N. 79 W. 2.57 to a post oak 3x 0 m, thence S. 87 1/2 W. 1.80 to a stone 3x 0 m, thence S. 62 1/2 W. 7.2 links to a stone 3x 0 m; thence S. 31 1/2 W. 8.10 to a stake 3x N M in the middle of the railroad track; thence along the railroad track 10.70 to the beginning corner. Being the same tract conveyed to Louach Cotton Mills by Beaver Duck Mills, by deed dated June 26th, 1920 and being the property previously conveyed to McKee Manufacturing Co. by John Q. Babby, by deed dated April 19, 1906 and recorded in the P.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 4, page 11.
