to it in hand duly paid or and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

O. E. Smithwick

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in county and state aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Woodvale Ave. at corner of lot #217 and running thence with Woodvale Ave. N. 64-37 E. 70' to a stake, thence N. 25-23 W. 220' to a stake; thence S. 64-37 W. 70' to a stake; thence S. 25-33 E. 220' to the point of the beginning and being lot #216 of Traxler Park.

- 1. No. part of said lot shall be used for any purpose other than a single or multiple residence and outbuildings properly appertenant thereto.
2. No part of said lot shall be occupied by any person of the negroid races except in the capacity of a servant.
3. Out buildings properly appertenant to a residence shall be confined to the rear half of the lot upon which they are built unless they shall be integral to the residence to which they appertain.
4. No part of any residence may be built or extend nearer to the front property line of said lot than 35 ft.
5. No residence may be built upon any lot fronting upon Byrd Boulevard or Park Drive which shall have when completed, a reasonable value of less than \$4000 and no residence may be built upon any lots fronting upon Rock Creek Drive, Woodvale Ave. or Mountvista Ave. which shall when completed, have a reasonable value not less than \$3500.
6. No spirituous or malt liquor shall ever be manufactured or sold upon said lot.
7. These restrictions are imposed for the benefit of the grantor and may be modified by it when strict modification is desired by him to the best interest of all concerned.
