"all those lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, just outside of the City limits of Greenville, South Carolina, on the Laurens Road, in which is known as Hampton Annex, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 30 and 31, each having a frontage of 50 feet on Paine Street and a depth of 150 feet on Darwin Avenue, as shown on plat made by C. M. Turner, Jr., recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 59, being the same conveyed to J. Q. Ricker by H. P. Burridge by deed dated January 31, 1923, recorded in Book 87, Page 460.
