E. S. Eppes and E. B. Eppes;  
all that piece parcel and tract of land lying situated and  
being in Belton Township, State and County aforesaid known  
as a part of the land conveyed to me by the last will  
and testament of D. S. Eppes deceased adjoining lands of  
H. A. Fletcher, Milton Bates and to L. Eppes.

Beginning on an iron pin on the Pickens Road, Milton  
Bates thence running N. 85° E. st. 100 ch. to an iron pin,  
thence N. 20° E. st. 500 to head of branch, thence with the meanders  
of the branch to a stone above a shoal, thence S. 34° st. 12.00  
to a Sweet Gum, thence N. 80° st. 4.00 to a Black tree on
