(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John W. Farr, a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being situated in the County and State aforesaid and in Glassy Township having the following boundary beginning at a spruce pine near Picolett Creek thence west to a mahogany tree on said creek, thence about southwest to a chestnut, thence west to a poplar, thence southwest to a chestnut oak, thence east to a chestnut oak, thence northeast to a poplar, thence southwest to an oak on Jack Howard's line, thence with Jack Howard's line southeast to stake thence east course to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Jack Howard, Mary Phinley etc. containing one hundred and eighty two acres more or less. This being the same property conveyed to me by Harriet Howard et al recorded in R. M. C. Office Greenville County, S.C. by deed dated August 7, 1923 in Vol. 90 page 116.

I Also, a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being situated in, the County and State aforesaid and in Glassy Township on the head waters of South Picolett River, having the following metes and bounds: beginning at the camp branch Daniel Ballew line on a stake, thence nearly east to the fork of the branch, thence west to a chestnut oak; thence nearly north to a hickory near the dug road; thence with said road a chestnut oak, thence nearly west chestnut, thence nearly south beginning corner, ^{containing} eighty two acres more or less, bounded by lands of Earl Sudduth and others; this being the same property conveyed to me by James A. Howard, by deed dated July 6, 1923, recorded in R. M. C. Office Greenville County, S.C. in Vol. 88 page 301.
